You need to enter some personal details to use the service. This is so we can contact you if something goes wrong. We may also contact you to ask you about your thoughts on the service, and how we can make things better.

#### About the service

The service is currently in "beta." This means it is only available with an access code and at certain times, Monday to Friday between 09:00 and 17:00. This is so we can test the service and make improvements before making it available to everyone.

You should only use the online service to report suspected water pollution. For all other environmental problems, please use the telephone hotline, 0800 80 70 60 (24-hour service). You do not need to report water pollution using both the online form and the hotline.
